October 1st at 10:00 am

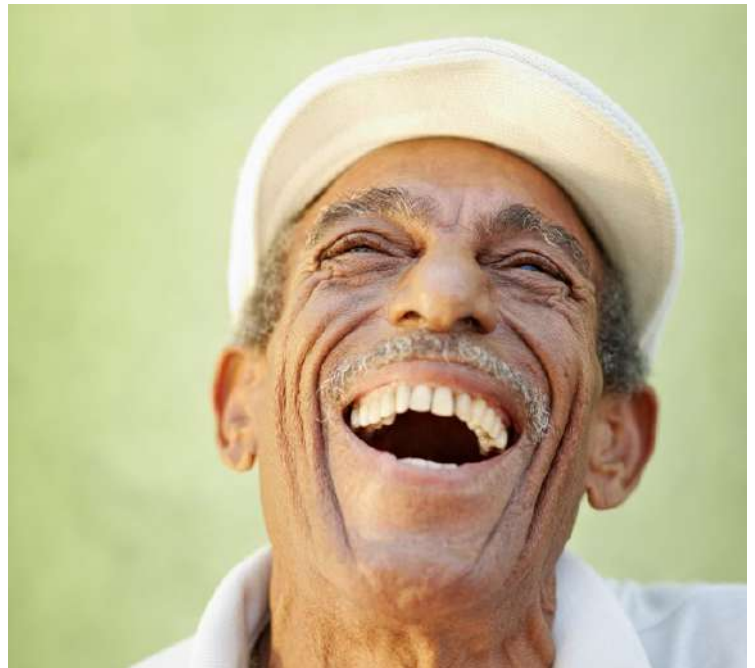
Come by the cafe and enjoy your warm drink of choice at this coffee and tea social!

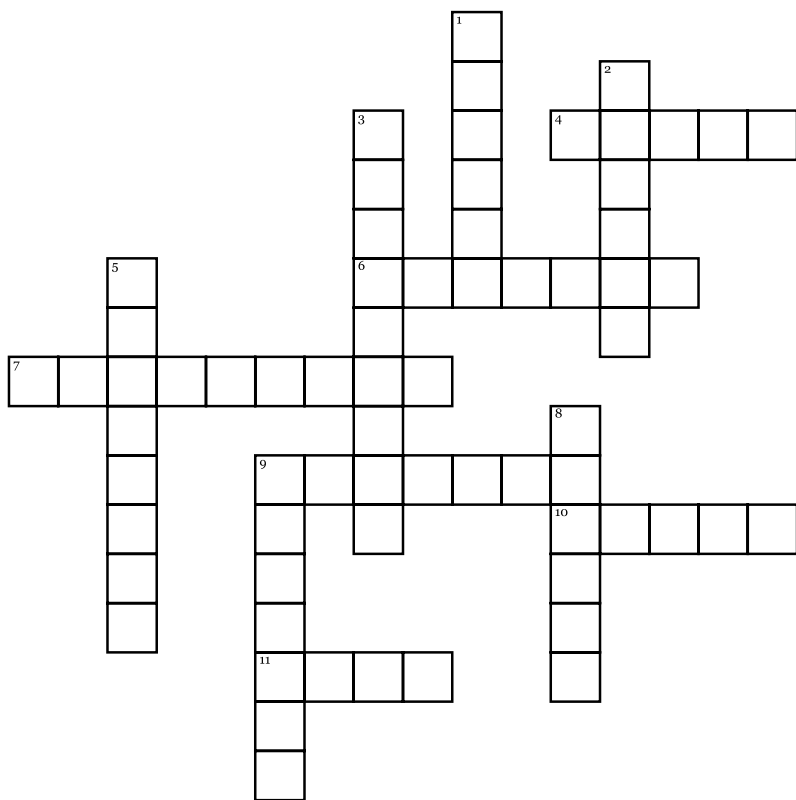

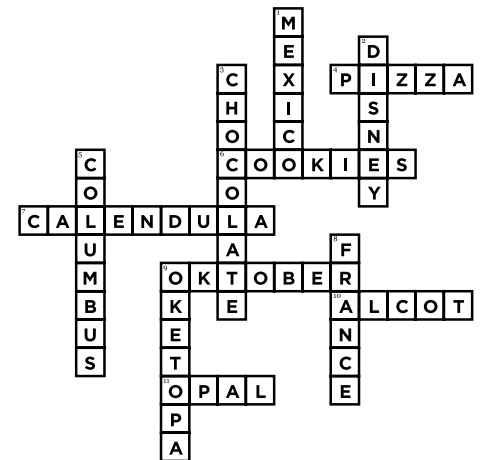
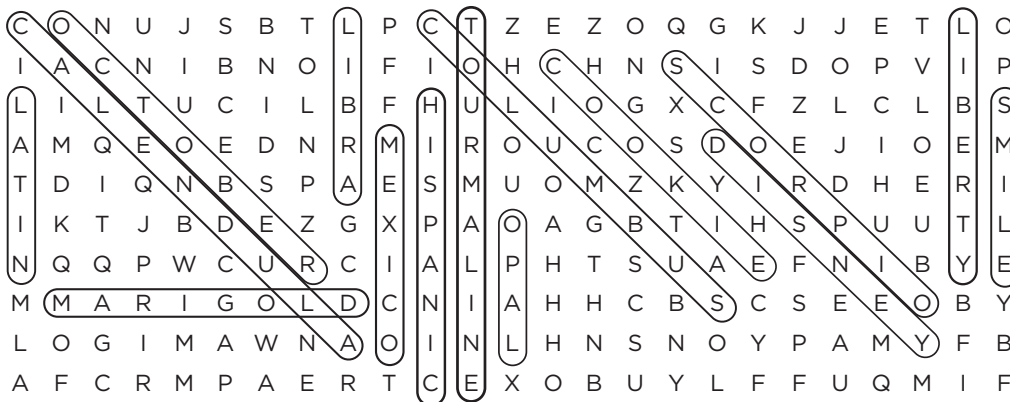
Tashiauna Griffin
